This will be a busy, exciting and stressful time. Below is a list of things that will help make your move into St. Joseph's at Fleming a little easier.

## For Administration:

- Power of Attorney of Finance Papers
- Power of Care Papers
- Health Card – Have correspondence forwarded to Home for renewal purposes
- Social Insurance Number
- Birth Certificate
- Veteran's number, if applicable
- Benefit information, if applicable
- Address and information of all key contact people
- Correct Birth date
- 3 cheques
- Ontario Disability Support Program - copy of monthly statement, if applicable
- Notice of assessment from previous year, if applicable

## For Nursing:

- All Medications including all over the counter medications used.
- Over the counter medications will not be ordered through our pharmacy.
- Health Care Directive (i.e.) do not resuscitate wishes.
- Funeral arrangements (i.e.) name of funeral home.

## For Environmental Services:

### Clothing:

- All clothing will be labeled for you by the home.
- Please do not bring unwashed items.
- "Dry clean only" is not appropriate
- Recommend 8 to 10 changes of everything
- Underwear, Socks, Bras and or Undershirts
- T Shirts and or Tops – easy care
- Pants – easy care
- Non slip shoes and slippers
- Nighties or pajamas
- Cardigan sweaters – 2 to 3
- Housecoat – 1 or 2
- Please rotate clothing seasonally for your loved one
- Panty Hose are not appropriate
- **Please bring clothing off hanger and in bags**

### Labeling and Identification of personal items:

- Using a sharpie marker please put your loved ones name on **ALL non clothing** items you bring into the home.
- Glasses, Dentures, rings and watches will also need to be labeled.

**Furniture:**

- **For safety reasons, the Home has the right to check and restrict what can and cannot be brought into a Resident's room.**
- You are responsible for moving in furniture – have enough support for day of move in.
- No nails are to be used on the walls to hang pictures, only 3M hangers or an equivalent product is acceptable. They are sold at reception
- You are responsible for your own batteries and light bulbs

**For Nutrition Services:**

- Residents and families will have an opportunity to meet with our Registered Dietitian to discuss dietary needs.

**For Recreation & Therapy Services:**

- Residents and families will have an opportunity to meet with our special services teams to discuss their personal, spiritual, cultural, intellectual, unique needs.
